

Comment on cremation after death:

The Savior said to me, J.: "Cremating people is not Catholic." The human heart is the temple of the Holy Spirit. When I, J., prayed to the Savior in the church in Konnersreuth a few years ago and wanted to visit Therese Neumann's grave, the Savior said during the prayer in the church: "You can now go to Theres' grave, she is waiting for you there." Then I, J., said to the Savior: why, she is in heaven and not in the grave. The Savior then said: "She can be there in heaven and at the grave."

Then I, J., quickly went to the grave and prayed.

Therese also spoke to me, I could hear her in my heart.
